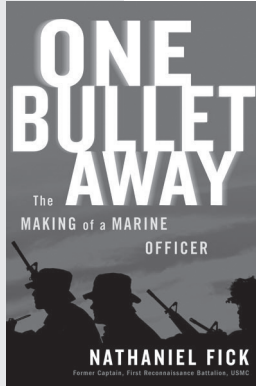

Nathaniel Fick is an MBA candidate at the Harvard Business School, and author of the New York Times bestseller, *One Bullet Away*. The book was named one of the “Best Books of 2005” by the *Washington Post*. He was commissioned a second lieutenant in the United States Marine Corps after graduating with high honors from Dartmouth College in 1999.

Fick led his infantry platoon in Afghanistan and Pakistan only weeks after the 9/11 attacks, and later led a Marine Recon platoon during the earliest months of the war in Iraq. He left the Marines as a captain in 2004, and earned a master’s degree in International Security Policy at Harvard University’s John F. Kennedy School of Government. He is a member of the Board of Visitors at the Rockefeller Center for Public Policy at Dartmouth, and served as a Visiting Fellow at the Center for Strategic & International Studies in Washington.

Fick’s writing has appeared in the *New York Times*, the *Washington Post*, the *Los Angeles Times*, and many other publications. He has appeared on NPR, the BBC, CNN, Fox, and MSNBC. Nate Fick lives in Cambridge, Massachusetts.
